<u>LISTERIOSIS (2010)</u> CLINICAL DESCRIPTION In adults, invasive disease caused by <i>Listeria monocytogenes</i> manifests most commonly as meningitis or bacteremia; infection during pregnancy may result in fetal loss through miscarriage or stillbirth, or neonatal meningitis or bacteremia. Other manifestations can also be observed. LABORATORY CRITERIA FOR DIAGNOSIS A. Isolation of <i>L. monocytogenes</i> from a normally sterile site (e.g., blood or cerebrospinal fluid [CSF] or, less commonly, joint, pleural, or pericardial fluid) B. In the setting of miscarriage or stillbirth, isolation of <i>L. monocytogenes</i> from placental or fetal tissue CASE CLASSIFICATION - Confirmed: A clinically compatible case that is laboratory-confirmed COMMENT The usefulness of other laboratory methods such as fluorescent antibody testing or polymerase chain reaction to diagnose invasive listeriosis has not been established.
