Flu Outreach Campaign 2019-2020 Report

Introduction

Every year, the Los Angeles County (LAC) Department of Public Health (DPH) partners with community-based organizations across the County, such as churches and senior centers, to offer the influenza (flu) vaccine at no charge for individuals who either do not have health insurance or do not have access to no-cost flu vaccinations through their regular healthcare provider. From October 2019 through March 2020, DPH administered 12,073 vaccinations at 235 outreach clinics in SPAs (Service Planning Areas) 1-8. Community Field Services (CFS) collaborated with the Immunization Program and the Office of Health Assessment and Epidemiology (OHAE) to complete this considerable task, utilizing 278 vaccinators, 20 flu coordinators (consisting of 10 public health nurse flu coordinators and 10 supervising clinic nurses), 5 Nurse managers, and 10 data entry staff.

Methods

Outreach Planning

The influenza virus can adversely affect certain populations more than others. For this reason, it is of the utmost importance that at-risk groups be encouraged to receive the influenza vaccination. These groups include: pregnant women; children over 6 months of age; adults 50 years of age or older; persons who are immunocompromised due to a disease or medical condition; persons who have chronic medical conditions (such as heart disease, diabetes or who are overweight or obese); persons who work or live in a nursing home or long-term care facility; and healthcare and day care workers. Flu prevention for these groups is a public health priority. To this end, the CFS flu coordinators specifically selected community venues for the 2019-2020 flu season to target these high-risk groups – including schools, churches, community centers, homeless shelters, health fairs, libraries and skilled nursing facilities.

Outreach Tracking

The 2019-2020 Flu Vaccination Consent Form is similar to last year consent form (*Attachment A1*). Only inactivated flu vaccines were administered in 2019-2020 flu outreaches.

After the Consent Form was prepared, the twelve health centers in the eight Service Planning Areas participating in the outreach clinics developed schedules (Attachment A2) with the following information:

- Date of outreach
- Outreach start and end times
- Outreach, school, or POD designation
- Venue Type: community center, health fair, library, outreach, school, senior center, homeless shelter, winter shelter
- Target population (children, seniors, homeless, immunocompromised adults, etc.)
- Name of outreach venue
- Address of outreach venue

- Supervisorial district of outreach venue
- Doses administered in previous year (if the venue hosted an outreach the previous year)
- Number of doses requested

Outreach information from the schedules were compiled in the Flu Vaccination Inventory Log (Attachment A3) by data entry staff. This log had multiple intended uses, including documenting the receipt of cover sheets, documenting the receipt of outreach batches, assigning batches for data entry and summing the number of forms received and entered.

The 2019-2020 Cover Sheet remained unchanged from Flu Outreach 2018-2019 campaign (Attachment A4). At the end of each outreach session, consent forms were collected and, the number of vaccines administered was recorded on the Cover Sheet, which was reviewed by the nurse-in-charge according to protocols in the Flu Form Procedures (Attachment A5). The completed Cover Sheet was then faxed or e-mailed to data entry staff within three business days of the outreach. Once received by the data entry staff, information from the Cover Sheet was used to update the Vaccination Inventory Log and to update the codebook (Attachment A6) with any new vaccinator initials or vaccine lot numbers.

Signed consent forms were hand-delivered by CFS staff to OHAE staff for data entry. Upon arrival at OHAE, date of receipt and name of the staff member delivering the forms were recorded in the Vaccine Inventory Log. Batches of flu consent forms were stored in a locked cabinet in OHAE by date.

Weekly Flu Update

Every week, the Flu Vaccine Inventory Log was e-mailed to the CFS Flu Coordinator with the most recent status of all the flu outreaches, highlighting which Cover Sheets and batches were received. Beginning in November 2019, a summary of the data entry was included in the email with the following information:

- Total number of outreach batches received
- Number of outreaches entered
- Percentage of outreaches entered
- Number of forms entered
- Percentage of forms entered
- Number of forms not entered
- Percentage of forms not entered
- Reasons forms were not entered

Data Entry

In preparation for data entry, a codebook (Attachment A6), coded intake forms (Attachment A7) and password-protected single-user Microsoft Access databases (Attachment A8) were developed by data entry staff. The codebook was updated weekly as needed with new lot numbers, vaccinator initials and outreach site numbers from the Cover Sheets. A data entry protocol (Attachment A9) was also developed with instructions for handling the consent forms and completing data entry.

Once batches were received in OHAE, data entry assignments were issued. Data entry staff received Data Entry Completion Logs (Attachment A10) to record their completed assignments and any problems encountered during data entry. Upon completion of data entry, the Completion Log was submitted, and the Flu Vaccine Inventory Log was updated with the number of forms entered and the data entry completion date.

Bi-Monthly Flu Vaccine Update

As data entry progressed, three preliminary Flu Vaccine Accountability spreadsheets were emailed twice a month to the CDC Public Health Advisor (Attachment 11: Tables A1-A3). Table A1 includes the number of doses given by age group (6 months-2 years, 3-6 years, 7-18 years, 19-49 years, 50-64 years, and 65 years and over) and lot number for each date the health center hosted an outreach. Table A2 shows the number of doses given by age group and lot number for each health center, without stratifying by the date the vaccination was administered. Table A3 displays the number of doses given by age group for each lot number. Twenty records with missing date of birth and/or age were excluded from analysis. The final sample for analysis consisted of 12,073 clients.

Data Cleaning

Rigorous data cleaning techniques were used to check for possible errors in data entry. Password-protected Microsoft Access databases were imported via a secured network drive into SAS 9.4 software; a SAS program was created using the codebook and Cover Sheets as a reference. After completing data entry batches, data entry staff received data cleaning sheets to double-check possible entry errors against the original flu forms. Further data cleaning ensured that patient responses were consistent with other related fields. Due to a high percentage of missing information on gender, analysts used first names to partially impute gender to improve data quality.

In addition, routine checks were performed to make sure that the information on the cover sheets (such as vaccinators and lot numbers) correctly reflected the hardcopies, and in turn, the database. If any inconsistencies were found, a CFS Epidemiology Analyst and the nurse-incharge at the outreach site assisted in rectifying the cover sheets.

Key Findings

Participation

DPH _ flu outreaches from October 12, 2019 to March 5, 2020. During this time, 12,073 persons received the influenza vaccine. Clients completed a consent form, self-reporting their current or permanent address, city and their ZIP code of residence. Most participants were located throughout Los Angeles County and attended outreaches close to their residence.

Characteristics Profile by Health Center (Table 1)

Gender: Overall, more females than males received the influenza vaccine at the DPH outreaches (56% versus 43%, respectively). This was also true when looking at the gender distribution for outreaches by the managing health center; Antelope Valley and Whittier Health Centers had the highest percentage of females (60%), while Central and Hollywood-Wilshire (52%) had the lowest.

Age group: Persons receiving the flu vaccine ranged in age from 6 months to 110 years old (mean = 45, SD = 21; data not shown). Many clients were in the targeted older age groups – age 55-64 years (21%) or 45-54 (18%) – and an additional 14% were children between 6 months and 17 years of age. Outreach events run by Antelope Valley Health Center had the highest percentage of children (26%), whereas Simms-Mann outreach events had the highest percentage of adults age 65 years or older (31%). Clients ages 55-64 comprised 21% of the total sample, but made up a quarter (25%) of private and uninsured clients and made up 30% of those using other types of insurance.

Race/Ethnicity: Overall, Asian and Hispanic clients accounted for the largest proportions of clients receiving influenza vaccines (38% and 36%, respectively), followed by Whites at 14%. Only 5% of persons receiving the flu vaccine at outreach sites identified as Black or African American. However, race/ethnicity representation varied by health center-operated outreach site. Asian clients accounted for the majority of persons receiving flu vaccine at Monrovia (75%), Central (70%), and Hollywood Wilshire (65%) health centers. In contrast, Hispanic clients represented the majority of persons at outreaches for Antelope Valley (68%), Martin Luther King Jr. Center for Public Health (75%), Pacoima (52%), and Whittier (53%).

Language of the Survey: Overall, most clients who received the influenza vaccination opted to fill out the consent form in English (64%), while 21% of clients used the Spanish form, 12% used the Korean form, and 2% the Chinese form. Distribution of consent form languages varied across managing health centers.

Insurance Status: Many outreach clients, 34%, indicated they were uninsured, while 25% indicated that they had private insurance. Insurance status varied across managing health centers. Outreach events managed by the Martin Luther King Jr. Center for Public Health had the highest percentage of uninsured clients (48%), while those managed by Pomona and Simms-Mann had the lowest (24% and 23%), respectively.

Vaccine Type: Only inactivated vaccines were administered during 2019-2020 flu outreaches.

Manufacturer: All vaccines were from the manufacturer Glaxo Smith Kline (GSK).

Site of Injection: At DPH health center-managed influenza outreaches, the majority of clients received the vaccination in their left deltoid (77%). The remainder received the vaccine in the right deltoid (21%), in the left thigh (1%), and in the right thigh (<1%).

Characteristics by Service Planning Areas (Table 2)

Gender: The gender distribution of vaccine recipients was similar across Service Planning Areas. Approximately 56% of all clients were female and 43% male. SPA 1 and SPA 7 had the highest percentage of females (60%) and SPA 4 had the lowest (52%).

Age group: The age distribution of clients varied greatly by SPA. SPA 1 and SPA 2 vaccinated the largest proportion of 6-month to 17-year-old clients (26% and 23%, respectively), while SPA 5 and 3 vaccinated the largest proportion of persons aged 65 years and older (31% and 26% respectively).

Race/Ethnicity: Race/ethnicity also varied greatly by SPA. SPA 3 and 4 had majority Asian clients with 63% and 68% respectively. SPA 1, 2, 6, and 7 had majority Hispanic/Latino clients at 68%, 52%, 75%, and 53% respectively. Almost half (47%) of clients at SPA 5 were White/Non-Hispanic.

Language of the Survey: Survey languages varied greatly throughout the county: SPA 5 utilized the largest proportion of English surveys (98%); SPAs 1, 2, and 6 utilized the largest proportion of Spanish surveys (38%, 32%, and 58%, respectively); SPA 3 utilized the largest proportion of Chinese surveys (11%); and SPAs 4 utilized the largest proportion of Korean surveys (45%).

Insurance Status: SPA 5 had the largest proportion of Medicare recipients (20%), while SPA 1 and SPA 2 had the largest proportion of Medicaid recipients (33% and 31%, respectively). The largest proportion of privately insured individuals that were vaccinated was in SPA 5 (38%). In contrast, SPA 6 had the largest proportion of uninsured clients (48%), followed by SPA 7 (44%).

Manufacturer: All SPAs utilized vaccines manufactured by Glaxo Smith Kline.

Characteristics by Insurance Type (Table 3)

The Department of Public Health vaccinated 12,073 clients; the number and proportion of clients who were uninsured was 4,137 (34%) compared to those who had private insurance (n=3,015; 25%). Less than a quarter had Medicaid/Medi-Cal (n=2,636; 22%).

Gender: When stratifying by gender, females were the majority across all types of insurance Medicare, Medicaid, private, and uninsured. The distribution of males and females were approximately similar across all insurance status types.

Age: As expected, the majority of clients who had Medicare were 65-74 years of age (58%), followed by those 75 years and older (42%). Twenty-four percent of Medicaid clients were under 18 years of age. Another 16% of Medicaid clients were 55-64 years old. Clients aged 55-64 comprised 21% of the total sample, but a quarter (25%) of private and uninsured clients, and 30% of those using other types of insurance.

Race/Ethnicity: Asian clients constituted 48% of those who were privately insured despite only 38% of the sample identifying as Asian. Clients who utilized Medicaid were largely Hispanic

(45% versus 36% of the sample), followed by Asians (30% versus 38% of the sample). While whites made up only 14% of the sample, they accounted for the largest percentage of those who had Medicare (39%). The majority of the uninsured were Hispanic/Latino and Asian (47% and 37%, respectively. The majority of those who did not know their insurance were Asian (45%).

Language of the Survey: Overall, English speakers made up the majority of respondents (64%), a higher percentage of those with private insurance and on Medicare (79% and 80%, respectively). Spanish surveys were used by 21% of respondents, however those that chose Spanish Survey made up about a third of uninsured clients.

Insurance Types (Tables 3a and 3b)

Table 3a and Table 3b display the characteristics of people with private insurance and without private insurance, stratified by co-insurance options (clients were able to choose more than one insurance type for the survey). Twenty-five percent of the total sample (n=3,015) reported having private insurance (private only or some combination of private insurance and Medicare, Medicaid and/or other insurance). Of the 12,073 clients vaccinated, 75% were without private insurance – that is they did not know their insurance status, were uninsured, or had some combination of Medicare, Medicaid and/or other insurance; n=9,058). Of those without private insurance, 46% did not have any type of insurance (n=4,137).

Target Populations (Table 4)

Outreach efforts were implemented to reach certain high-risk populations to ensure that they were receiving the vaccine. Out of a total of 235 flu outreaches, several outreach efforts were targeted towards children (4%), seniors (3%) and homeless (48%). Most of the outreach efforts had multiple targeted populations. In fact, 64% of outreaches were targeted to all specified groups.

Number of outreach events (Figure 1)

Overall, the Department of Public Health offered 235 flu outreach events throughout Los Angeles County. On average, DPH vaccinated 51 clients per event. All Los Angeles County Service Planning Areas participated in this flu outreach campaign. SPA 4 and SPA 7 managed the most events (53 and 41, respectively). The largest average number of clients per outreach was seen in SPA 3, with approximately 74 clients per event.

Percent of clients vaccinated by venue (Figure 2)

Clients were vaccinated at different venues throughout Los Angeles County. The highest percentage of clients were vaccinated at churches (35%; n=4,265), followed by libraries (24%; n=2,874), community outreach/health fairs (14%; n=1,659), community centers (11%; n=1,291), senior centers (7%; n=823), schools (2%; n=294), and homeless shelters (including winter shelters) (1%; n=139).

Number of clients vaccinated by venue and by SPA (Figures 3-10)

As stated above, many clients were vaccinated at church venues. San Gabriel (SPA 3) (Figure 5), Metro (SPA 4) (Figure 6), and South (SPA 6) (Figure 8) had the highest number of clients vaccinated at their church-based outreach sites, with the highest number in SPA 4 (n=1,952) (Figure 6). San Fernando (SPA 2), San Gabriel (SPA 3) and SPA 7 (East) had the highest number of clients vaccinated at libraries, with the highest number in SPA 7 (n=572 in 14 outreaches).

Number of clients vaccinated by venue and by race group (Figures 11-16)

Church venues were the most popular locations for Asian (n=2,612) and Hispanic/Latino (n=1,189) clients to receive the flu vaccination (Figures 11 and 13). The highest number of African-American, White/Non-Hispanic, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, American Indian/Native Alaskan clients were vaccinated at libraries (n=109, n=602, n=31 and n=12, respectively).

Number of clients vaccinated by venue and by age group (Figures 17-25)

When stratifying by age groups, almost all age groupings had the highest number of clients vaccinated at church outreaches. The exceptions were clients less than 5 years old and 25-34 years old that were vaccinated at libraries (n=102 and n=331 respectively) (Figures 17 and 20). Finally, clients 75 years and older were most frequently vaccinated at community centers (n=219) (Figure 25).

Maps (Figures 26-36)

Flu outreach sites were operated throughout Los Angeles County. A majority of persons receiving the flu vaccine were located in ZIP codes that were close to one of the outreach locations (Figure 26). SPA 3 (San Gabriel) and SPA 4 (Metro) had the most Los Angeles County residents vaccinated (Figure 27). When analyzing by Supervisorial District, Districts 1 and 2 had the highest number of persons vaccinated (Figure 28). Though most clients were located near the outreach sites, there were many clients who resided in a ZIP code that was not close to the outreach that they attended (Figures 29-36).

Characteristics of clients vaccinated at flu outreach clinics during the seven years of flu outreach campaigns 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 (Figures 37-42)

The number of persons vaccinated during flu outreach campaigns decreased in 2019-2020 (n=12,073) compared to 2018-2019 (n=13,113). Previous years have shown a steady decline in the number of persons vaccinated (n=13,388 in 2016-2017; n=16,905 in 2015-2016, n=20,953 in 2014-2015, and n=20,607 in 2013-2014). However, the distribution of many socio-demographic factors of clients did not vary over time. The distribution of gender remained relatively consistent over seven years of flu outreach (56-59% females, 39-43% males) (*Figure 37*). The client's age group distribution over the seven flu campaigns also remained fairly steady with the highest percentage of those vaccinated being aged 55-64 years old (ranging from 21% to 23%) (*Figure 38*). Some variation was seen over the seven flu campaigns regarding race, with Hispanics/Latinos (ranging from 34% to 41%) and Asians (ranging from 33% to 39%) constituting the majority of clients. Of note, Hispanic/Latino clients experienced a decrease in vaccinations

(41% to 36%) over the past seven years. On the other hand, Asian clients have experienced an increase in vaccinations over the past seven years (33% to 39%) (Figure 39). Overall, the distribution of clients by SPA did not vary; however, the highest proportions vaccinated from 2013-2017 was SPA 3, with a range between 21% and 24%; however, from 2017 onward, SPA 4 had the highest percentage of clients vaccinated from 25% to 27% (Figure 41).

There were some differences in the health insurance status of clients over the seven years of data. The percentage of uninsured clients increased (34%) compared to the declining trend for previous 6 years (from 39% in 2013-2014 to 35% in 2014-2015, 31% in 2015-2016, 27% in 2016-2017, 27% in 2017-2018, and 29% in 2018-2019). On the other hand, the percentage of clients with private health insurance decreased in the 2019-2020 campaign (25%) compared to 2018-2019 (28%) despite the increasing trend in previous years (20% in 2013-2014 to 27% in 2014-2015, 26% in 2015-2016, 28% in 2016-2017, and 33% in 2017-2018) (*Figure 40*). Although venue types where clients were vaccinated changed slightly over time, the highest percentage of clients was consistently vaccinated at churches (34%-39%). There was an increase in clients vaccinated at libraries in the current year (24%) compared to previous years (18% in 2018-2019 and 2017-2018, 12% in 2016-2017 and 11% in 2015-2016). Of note, clients vaccinated in schools dropped significantly to 2% compared to previous year (8% in 2018-2019 (*Figure 42*).

Percentage of uninsured clients vaccinated at flu outreach clinics in 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by gender, age group, race/ethnicity, SPA, insurance status and venue type (Figures 43-47)

There was an increasing trend in the distribution of males among uninsured clients over time (37-42%) (*Figure 43*). The distribution of clients by age group did not change notably over time, with the exception of the 55-64 age group, which constituted 33% of all uninsured clients in 2013-2014, but a decreased range of 24%-26% in subsequent years (*Figure 44*). In all seven flu outreach campaigns, the highest percentage of uninsured clients were among Hispanics/Latinos (47-56%) followed by Asians (31-37%). Of note, there was slight declining trend for Hispanics/Latinos and a slight increasing trend for Asian clients over time in the number of uninsured (*Figure 45*). Figure 46 shows that the distribution of uninsured clients by SPA did not vary considerably over the first three years with the highest percentage of uninsured being vaccinated in SPA 6 (23-25%), followed by SPA 4 (17-21%). However, in 2016-2017 and 2017-2018, there was a notable decrease for SPA 6 (25% to 19% to 12%) and an increasing trend the past two years (15% in 2018-2019 and 17% in 2019-2020. Conversely, there was an increase for SPA 4 (20% to 29% to 35%) from 2015-2017 and a subsequent decline in 2018-2019 (30%) and 2019-2020 (25%) (*Figure 46*). In all seven years of flu outreach campaigns, the highest percentage of uninsured clients was vaccinated at churches (38-48%) (*Figure 47*).

Health insurance status of clients vaccinated at flu outreach clinics in 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity and by SPA (Figures 48-55)

Although health insurance status varied by race/ethnicity in all seven years of flu outreach campaigns and by Service Planning Areas, the highest percentage of uninsured was consistently

Hispanic/Latino clients with some exceptions: Other (2016-2017), AI/AN (2018-2019), and NH/PI (2019-2020) in SPA 1 (*Figure 48*), NH/PI (2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018), AI/AN (2013-2014 and 2018-2019), Other (2019-2020) in SPA 2 (*Figure 49*), AI/AN (2013-2014, and 2019-2020), NH/PI (2018-2019) in SPA 3 (*Figure 50*), AI/AN (2013-2014, 2016-2017, 2018-2019) in SPA 4 (*Figure 51*), AI/AN (2013-2014, 2017-2018, 2019-2020, Asians (2015-2016) in SPA 5 (*Figure 52*), AI/AN (2013-2014) in SPA 6 (*Figure 53*), AI/AN (2016-2017) in SPA 7 (*Figure 54*), and AI/AN (2013-2014), Other (2019-2020) in SPA 8 (*Figure 55*). Of note, an extremely small number of Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders and American Indians/Alaskan Natives determined the higher percentage of uninsured.

Limitations

Results from the Influenza Outreach Campaign are subject to several limitations. First, results may be subject to recall bias because analysis relied on self-reported data. The patient filled out the first half of the Vaccine Consent Form, including socio-demographic characteristics, while the nursing staff completed the vaccine information in the second half. This process may lead to some misclassification and cause some measures to be either under or over-reported. In addition, homeless status was not explicitly obtained from the consent form, possibly underestimating the number of people experiencing homelessness that received a flu vaccination. One of the County's recent priorities has been to reach out to this vulnerable population of over 60,000 (LA County Homeless Count). Missing data is also a pervasive problem with assessment surveys. Checking for completed forms before the patient leaves the flu outreach is essential to maintaining the integrity of the data and its usefulness.

Lastly, the results of this survey may not be generalizable to the general population because data was collected from specific outreach sites in Los Angeles County – they were not chosen in a random fashion. It is important to note that this is a not a longitudinal study and the results should not be interpreted or be used in such a manner.

What We Learned

One of the goals of the DPH-operated annual flu campaigns is to vaccinate the uninsured. This flu season was no exception, with 4,136 vaccinated clients (34%) reporting that they had no health insurance. Over the past seven years, the number of uninsured clients first declined then stabilized, and now has increased. It is also important to note that around 7,000 people with private and public (Medicare and Medicaid) insurance received a flu shot. These results demonstrate that these free flu clinics serve both as a "safety net" for the uninsured and as a preferred provider for some who are insured.

This report highlighted efforts to immunize targeted populations such as children, seniors, homeless and immunocompromised adults and outreaches were conducted in a variety of venues to reach these groups. We learned that it is important to offer the consent form in multiple languages as only 67% of clients completed the English consent form.

Finally, the success of this flu campaign can be attributed to the tremendous work of the hundreds of staff members and volunteers who completed a massive task of tracking and entering 12,073 outreach forms.






Figure 3. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 1 (Antelope Valley) by venue type (n=17), 2019-2010 Flu Outreach Campaign.






Figure 4. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 2 (San Fernando) by venue type (n=29), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 7. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 5 (West) by venue type (n=12), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 8. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 6 (South) by venue type (n=28), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 9. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 7 (East) by venue type (n=41), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.







Figure 10. Number of clients vaccinated at flu outreach sites in Service Planning Area 8 (South Bay) by venue type (n=23), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.






















Figure 15. Number of Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander clients (n=78) vaccinated at flu outreach sites by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.






Figure 16. Number of American Indian/ Alaskan Native clients (n=58) vaccinated at flu outreach sites by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.








Figure 18. Number of clients age 5-17 (n=1,492) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 19. Number of clients age 18-24 (n=582) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 20. Number of clients age 25-34 (n=1,192) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.





Figure 21. Number of clients age 35-44 (n=1,722) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.








Figure 23. Number of clients age 55-64 (n=2,544) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 24. Number of clients age 65-74 (n=1,335) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 25. Number of clients 75 and older (n=759) vaccinated at flu outreaches by venue type, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign.





Figure 26. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence (n=11,153*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.




Figure 28. Number of Clients by Supervisorial District of Outreach (n=12,073), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.




Figure 29. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence at SPA 1 Outreaches (n=500*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 -March 5, 2020.




Figure 30. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence at SPA 2 Outreaches (n=1,544*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.




Figure 31. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence at SPA 3 Outreaches (n=2,103*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.





Figure 32. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence at SPA 4 Outreaches (n=2,755*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.




Figure 34. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence at SPA 6 Outreaches (n=1,437*), 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.





Figure 35. Number of Clients by Zip Code of Residence (n=1,260*) at SPA 7 Outreaches, 2019-2020 Flu Outreach Campaign, October 12, 2019 - March 5, 2020.




Figure 37. Clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics by gender, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, respectively, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 38. Clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics by age group, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, respectively, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 40. Clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics by insurance status, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, respectively, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 41. Clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics by Service Planning Area, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, respectively, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 42. Clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics by venue type, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, respectively, Flu Outreach Campaign.





Figure 43. Uninsured clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach Clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, by gender, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 45. Uninsured clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach Clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity, Flu Outreach Campaign.




Figure 46. Uninsured clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach Clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, and 2018-2019, by Service Planning Area, Flu Outreach Campaign.





Figure 47. Uninsured clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach Clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by venue type, Flu Outreach Campaign.





Figure 48 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 1 (Antelope Valley), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 49. Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 2 (San Fernando), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 50 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 3 (San Gabriel), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 51 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 4 (Metro LA), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 52 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 5 (West LA), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 53 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 6 (South LA), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 54 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 7 (East LA), Flu Outreach Campaign.*





Figure 55 (continued). Insurance status of clients vaccinated at Flu Outreach clinics, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020 by race/ethnicity in Service Planning Area 8 (South Bay), Flu Outreach Campaign.*

2019-2020 CHS Influenza Form Procedures

Purpose: To have a procedure in place to ensure that the influenza (flu) consent forms and cover sheets, are accurately completed, and promptly transported to the Office of Health Assessment and Epidemiology (OHAE) for data entry purposes. Outreach clinics are defined as any flu clinic conducted outside of the Department of Public Health (DPH) in-house immunization clinic.

Influenza Outreach Forms

The following forms shall be provided to patients receiving an influenza vaccination:

- Vaccine Information Sheet
- 2019-2020 Influenza Consent Form

During the outreach

- The nurse in-charge of the outreach clinic <u>must</u> review and complete the CHS Influenza Coversheet. Indicate if each participant is a vaccinator or screener.
- Each person participating in the outreach should sign his/her own name and initials on the Coversheet.
 - o Initials should be signed the same was as they are signed on the *Flu Vaccination* Form 2019-2020.
- All flu doses administered at outreach clinics conducted by CHS staff will utilize the Flu Vaccination Form 2019 -2020.
- Screeners must review each vaccination form to ensure the following fields are complete, accurate, and legible:
 - Last Name
 - o First Name
 - Date of Birth
 - o Zip Code
 - o Phone Number
 - o Gender
 - o Mother's First Name
 - o Race/ethnicity
 - o Pregnancy Status
 - o Manufacturer
 - Lot Number
 - Site of Administration
 - Staff Initials
 - Date of Administration
 - o Insurance Coverage

Checklist to Prepare Forms for Data Entry

After the outreach:

- The nurse in-charge must review and complete the Cover Sheet for CHS Flu Outreach Clinics, 2019-2020 and attach to the vaccination consent forms. All of the information on the cover sheet must be completed.
- Check to make sure all of the names and initials of the screeners and vaccinators are listed on the Cover Sheet for CHS Flu Outreach Clinics, 2019-2020.
- Sort the "2019-2020 Flu Vaccination Consent Forms" by the vaccinator's initials. For example, all forms signed by Susan R. Smith with the initials SRS should be paper clipped together.
- Review the vaccination forms for completeness. Correct forms missing the following information:
 - o Type of vaccine
 - o Lot numbers should match those listed on the cover sheet
 - o Date vaccine administered

CHS Flu Outreach Cover Sheets

After the outreach clinic:

- Within 3 business days of the flu outreach, the flu coordinator (or designee) shall fax or email the CHS Flu Outreach Cover Sheets to the OHAE. Faxed forms should be sent to:

- The flu coordinator (or designee) shall ensure all consent forms are properly batched with the CHS Flu Outreach cover sheet on top and delivered to the OHAE on the Monday following the outreach. Forms should be delivered to:

- Once all forms are entered, the OHAE will send all batched forms to CHS Administration, to the attention of Angela Austin, CHS Flu Coordinator.
- The CHS Flu Coordinator will work with the Area Nurse Managers to ensure that these batched forms are returned to the appropriate health center.



Receiving Your Data Entry Assignment

CHS will deliver forms to Jason Bostrom or Edgar Elvira weekly. These batches WILL BE logged in by Jason/Edgar. Jason/Edgar will verify the information on the cover sheet and Leila will record this information in the Data Entry Log. Data entry staff will receive an email stating when a new batch becomes available. Once you receive the Data Entry Completion Log from Leila, you may pick up your batch from the locked cabinet in Room 127.

Receiving Your Batch


- 1) After obtaining the batch, record the date you received the forms on the Data Entry Completion Log.
- 2) Check that the outreach date on the Cover Sheet matches the Date Administered field on the forms. Also check the lot numbers against the Cover Sheet in order to ensure that lot numbers are valid and were used on the date of the outreach. If there is a discrepancy, please email Leila, Grace, Bryant or Jennifer.

Sorting and Counting the Forms

- 1) Sort the Flu Vaccination Consent Forms by the vaccinator's initials (group all the forms with the same vaccinator together). Please remember to number the forms in sequential order (upper right corner) in pencil and keep the forms in the order of data entry by using paper clips/binder clips after data entry is complete so data cleaning will be more efficient. On a post-it, write the vaccinator code and the total number of forms counted for that vaccinator and attach to the first page of clipped forms.
- 2) Match the vaccinator's initials on the forms to the initials on the Cover Sheet. If the vaccinator's initials are on the form, but missing from the Cover Sheet, scan and email the flu consent form (bottom half starting from "Manufacturer and Lot Number") and the cover sheet to Leila. Leila will forward the information to Angela or a Nurse Manager and include you on the email. Do not enter the form until a response from Leila is received in addition to an updated codebook.
- 3) If there are duplicate forms/carbon copies, do not enter the duplicate. Count as one and staple the duplicate forms together. If a duplicate was entered by mistake, document the ID number of the duplicate form in the "Problems Encountered" section of the completion log, but do not delete from the database.
- 4) Count the number of Vaccination Consent Forms and record that number on the Data Entry Completion Log.
- 5) If you receive forms that are in a language other than English and require translation (i.e., Spanish, Chinese or Korean), please inform Leila. They will contact the appropriate person for translation. Please put a post-it on the edge of forms that need translations. Please enter all other forms in your batch while waiting for translation. If you do not have other forms, another batch will be assigned to you in the meantime. After translations have been received, finish your current batch and then return to the previous batch to enter translations.

The Database

The Access databases will be stored on the shared drive named **chs-epi**. A file folder with your name will house all databases assigned to you by Leila Family. You will receive a separate email with the password for the databases.

Begin Data Entry

- Double-check the name of the database, site number, and outreach date against the Cover Sheet in your batch.
- When navigating through the database, use the Tab key to quickly move between fields. All text entered will appear as uppercase.
- Enter the information as best as you can read it on the Flu Vaccination Consent Form.
- Enter exactly what is documented on the form.
- Do not fill in missing information or write on the forms in any way.
- Refer to the codebook for all additional data entry instructions.
- If you are in the middle of a batch at the end of your shift, return the forms to the cabinet and email Leila Family to let her know that you are in the process of data entry and will continue later.

What to do after a batch is entered

- 1) Complete the Data Entry Completion Log (number of forms entered, database name, and any problems encountered).
- 2) Email and scan a copy of the Data Entry Completion Log and cover sheets to Leila, Grace, and Bryant to notify them that data entry is complete. Use the name of the database as the subject line of your email AND the title of the PDF document (<u>first page</u>: Completion Log and <u>second page</u>: Cover Sheet). Please name the scanned Data Entry Completion Log the same as the database names.
- 3) Leila will put the scanned cover sheets and Completion Log onto the CHS-EPI shared drive.
- 4) Leila will update the Flu Master Log upon receiving the Data Entry Completion Log.
- 5) Return the forms to the cabinet.
- 6) If you are the last one leaving, please be sure to lock the cabinet drawer.
