- Bring a book, crossword puzzle, or other activities to keep you busy during your wait.
- Please eat and drink plenty of fluids before your arrival.
- If arriving with a guardian, an authorization letter from the parent must be provided during registration.
- If your child is getting an immunization, bring his or her yellow Immunization Card so it can be updated.
- Be on time for your follow-up appointment or it may be rescheduled; if you need to cancel an appointment, please do so at least 24 hours in advance.
- Please note, wait times may be longer than expected during peak hours.
