Almost 50 million visitors come to Los Angeles annually, making hospitality one of the leading sectors for job growth. Food service is one of the fastest growing subsectors and an estimated 18,880 new jobs will be added in the next 2 years.

THE LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LAX) IS EXPANDING

LAX is undergoing a \$14 billion dollar capital improvement project that will add 2,000 new concession/food service jobs to the airport.




LOS ANGELES COUNTY HAS THREE MAJOR EVENTS ON THE HORIZON
