MISSION

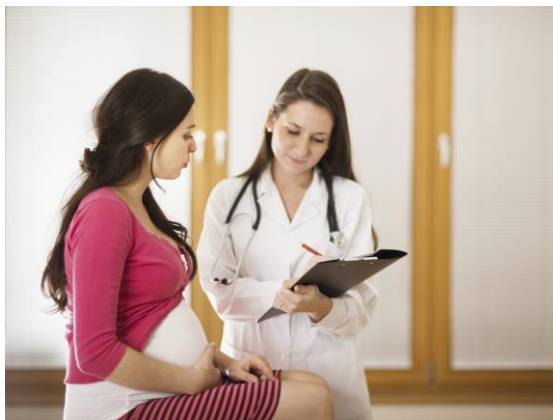
To foster collaborative efforts to prevent vaccine preventable diseases.

STRUCTURE

Constituency: A public/private partnership of Los Angeles County schools, hospitals, clinics, pharmacies, vaccine companies, managed care health plans, and local health department programs.

General Meetings: Participants meet three times a year to share information on best practice approaches to improving immunization coverage levels, vaccine-preventable disease surveillance updates, as well as advocacy/policy updates at the national, state, and local levels.
