ACADEMIC INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

WHO QUALIFIES?

Academic Internship applicants must be junior, senior, or graduate level students who are currently enrolled in good academic standing and will be completing their internships for academic credit at a partnering college/university. Upon joining the program, interns must be able to provide their own transportation to and from the internship site. As a general rule, interns are expected to be available at least 8 hours a week.

The Academic Internship Program is designed to place college/university students within County departments as student interns for the completion of specific projects, research, or studies ordered by the Board of Supervisors or developed by a County department.

These internships are unpaid and projects are carefully designed to offer each intern a practical and meaningful work experience. Participants normally spend 8-16 hours per week at their internship unless noted differently on the project description.
