The SNF Honors Program cycles annually with criteria for completion available from August through May of the Program season.

Public Health Engagement

- Update facility information with the <u>SNF Contacts Form</u> at least once
- Attend at least 6 Ask an IP sessions
- Sign up for **PSIE** (the Patient Safety and Information Exchange)

 - If you are already registered, please complete one of the other Criteria
- Attend 2 <u>Regional Healthcare Network</u> (RHN) sessions
 - Email <u>RHN@ph.lacounty.gov</u> with questions or submit <u>the RHN</u> <u>Contact Form</u> to make sure you get meeting invitations

Vaccination Coverage

SNFs must meet at least ONE

For the 2025-2026 winter respiratory season the facility must report coverage into NHSN:

- HCP Influenza vaccine coverage of 90% or higher for the season
- Resident COVID-19 vaccine coverage of 80% or higher for any single reporting week

Infection Prevention & Control Program Structure

SNFs must meet BOTH

- Email a screenshot of the facility IP's <u>CBIC</u> Certification to <u>LACSNF@ph.lacounty.gov</u> that includes name, certification type, and <u>CBIC ID number</u>
- <u>Submit a form</u> indicating the facility has employed the same individual in the IP role for at least 1 year

Preventive Action

SNFs must meet at least ONE

- Conduct 1 ICAR learn more and request a visit
- Complete 1 prospective MDRO PPS
