- → Calendar invitation
- → Agenda



DEVELOP THE ASSESSMENT Feedback from staff, observed noncompliance

Recruit assistance if needed. Explain their role in the targeted ICAR.

Calendar invitation with agenda and expectations.

- → Review policies.
- → Who will you interview?
- → What will you observe?
- → How will you capture this data?

A variety of healthcare workers.

- → How do you identify a resident on EBP?
- → When is PPE indicated?
- → What type of PPE is indicated?
- → How do you don/doff PPE?
- → What do you do if a resident is suspected of a different infectious organism?
- → What else would you ask?

- → Staff entering/exiting resident rooms with EBP signs posted
- → Staff starting/ending high contact resident care tasks
- → Staff starting/ending low contact resident care tasks
- → What else will you observe?




