## **Infection Prevention Best Practices Outbreak 101**

An **outbreak** is an occurrence of similar illnesses that are in excess of the normal expectancy for a given location and period of time.

2	Control the Outbreak	<ul> <li>Enforce respiratory &amp; hand hygiene. Wear PPE as indicated.</li> <li>Restrict certain activities depending on the organism.</li> <li>Consider placing similarly infected residents together (same room or wing).</li> <li>Send ill employees' home.</li> </ul>
3	Start a line list	Identify each case and include:  ☐ Room number or other location. ☐ Signs, symptoms and the onset date. ☐ Resident or staff demographics. ☐ Exposure to roommates or staff.
4	Notify staff and residents	<ul> <li>Provide an organism or disease fact sheet.</li> <li>Provide education on infection prevention.</li> <li>Provide procedures on what staff or residents should do if they develop signs or symptoms.</li> </ul>
