Outbreak 101

An **outbreak** is an occurrence of similar illnesses that are in excess of the normal expectancy for a given location and period of time.

Control the Outbreak

- Enforce respiratory & hand hygiene. Wear PPE as indicated.
- Restrict certain activities depending on the organism.
- Consider placing similarly infected residents together (same room or wing).
- Send ill employees' home.

Start a line list

- Identify each case and include:
- Room number or other location.
 - Signs, symptoms and the onset date.
 - Resident or staff demographics.
 - Exposure to roommates or staff.

4

Notify staff and residents

- Provide an organism or disease fact sheet.
- Provide education on infection prevention.
- Provide procedures on what staff or residents should do if they develop signs or symptoms.
