
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What is My Turn?

My Turn is a platform, created in 2021, that 1) connects individuals / patients with tools and resources to receive vaccination and 2) provides Clinic Managers (CMs) and Vaccine Administrators (VAs) the tools to manage vaccination clinics.

Clinic Managers may offer various vaccines for scheduling through My Turn. Patients can book appointments, and upon vaccination, their data will be submitted to IIS.

In short, My Turn has been an all-in-one application for clinic management, dose accountability, reporting, public scheduling, and walk-in registration.





CAIR Quick Entry and My Turn

- CAIR Quick Entry allows clinicians to report vaccine administration data to IIS. Although a My Turn account is required to use CAIR Quick Entry, you are not required to manage vaccine appointments in My Turn.
- CAIR Quick Entry can be used to report data for all vaccines accepted by CAIR, including flu, mpox, and COVID-19 vaccine.
- If you use My Turn to manage appointment scheduling, vaccine administration data will continue to be reported to IIS using the usual process.

How to Enroll in My Turn

Enrolling in My Turn **without** a myCAvax account

Enrolling in My Turn **with** a myCAvax account

1. Visit mycavax.cdph.ca.gov.

2. Select the 'My Turn' tab next to the 'Home' tab to view the 'My Turn' landing page.


2. Select the 'My Turn Enrollment' tab next to the 'Enrollment' tab to view the Enrollment page.

1. Log in to myCAvax using your usual credentials.

3. On the 'My Turn' landing page, select either the 'Enroll your organization' or 'Enroll Now' button. Begin enrolling in My Turn on the 'Step 1 -Create an account' page. 3. On the Enrollment page, select the 'Enroll Location' button. The page redirects to the 'Step 1 -Required Training' page to begin My Turn enrollment.

Requirements to Enroll in My Turn

To enroll in My Turn, you must meet the following requirements:





 Your location has not used My Turn or CAIR Quick Entry to date.

2. Your job responsibilities must include clinic operations or vaccine coordination for a clinic location. Your location must be enrolled in a California Immunization Registry.




What to Expect After Submitting Enrollment

After enrolling in My Turn:

- 1. You will receive an email communication upon submission.
- 2. The CDPH Enrollment Team will review and approve your application.
- 3. Once your application has been approved, you will receive an email confirming the approval.
- 4. Then, you will receive another email containing your login credentials for the My Turn platform.











Using CAIR Quick Entry





Introducing California Immunization Registry (CAIR) Quick Entry



Since the My Turn Release 46 on Wednesday, December 20, 2023, CAIR Quick Entry allows users to submit, view, and edit vaccine administration data for most vaccines to Immunization Information Systems (IIS).



Vaccines Eligible for CAIR Quick Entry

You can use CAIR Quick Entry to record vaccine administration data for any vaccine already offered by CAIR, including flu vaccine, COVID-19 vaccine, and mpox vaccine.



Using Inline Submission

Users can inline upload vaccine administration data using CAIR Quick Entry (which may look similar to the existing inline upload process for vaccines in My Turn).


