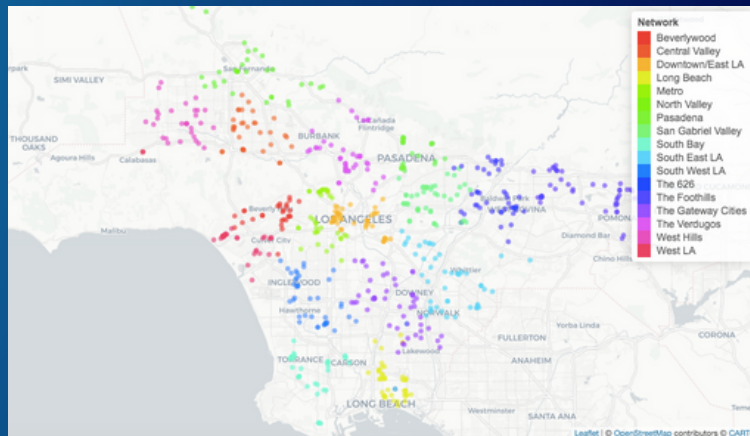


Regional Healthcare Network of Los Angeles County
