

HOW TO APPLY INSECT REPELLENT



- Always follow label directions and read precautions before applying
- Wash your hands with soap after, especially before eating and drinking
- Use only enough repellent to cover exposed skin (and clothes if using spray)
- If using spray, hold the spray 6-8 inches away and spray slowly and evenly



- Don't use any near your eyes, nose, mouth, ears, or open cuts
- Don't use on babies younger than 2 months
- Don't use under clothing
- Don't use to kill insects
- Don't reapply more often than directed by the product label

EPA-registered insect repellents come in different forms:

 WIPES

 SPRAY

 LOTION

Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered insect repellents with one of the active ingredients below:

- DEET
- Picaridin
- IR3535
- Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus (OLE)
- Para-methane-diol (PMD)
- 2-undecanone

When used as directed, EPA-registered insect repellents are proven safe and effective, even for pregnant and breastfeeding persons.
