

Urban Coalition for HIV/AIDS Prevention Services

The Urban Coalition for HIV/AIDS Prevention Services (UCHAPS) is a coalition of community members and health departments from the six local jurisdictions (Chicago, Houston, Los Angeles, New York, Philadelphia, San Francisco, and Washington D.C.) that are directly funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to conduct HIV Prevention programs.

Los Angeles County is represented at UCHAPS by two Governmental Representatives, two Community Representatives, one Governmental Alternate, and one Community Alternate. The Community Co-Chairs for the Los Angeles County HIV Prevention Planning Committee (PPC) are the Community Representatives at UCHAPS meetings. The PPC nominates and elects one other PPC member to serve as an alternate to UCHAPS.
