#### **Preparing for Your Visit**

These tips will help you get ready for your visit:

- Bring a book, crossword puzzle, or other activities to keep you busy during your wait.
- Eat before arrival. Eating and drinking is not allowed inside the clinic.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. If arriving with a guardian, an authorization letter from the parent must be provided during registration.
- If your child is getting an immunization, bring his or her yellow Immunization Card so it can be updated.
- Be on time if you have a follow-up appointment or it may be rescheduled; if you need to cancel an appointment, please do so at least 24 hours in advance.
