Physician Specialist – COVID-19 Outbreak Management Temporary positions



The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (DPH) is hiring at the position level of Physician Specialist for vacancies in various areas within the County.

POSITION SUMMARY

This position will be responsible for assisting the Department’s COVID-19 Outbreak Management Branch or the Persons Experiencing Homelessness Branch that manages COVID-19 outbreaks. The Physician Specialist will be required to make site visits to COVID-19 outbreak sites as needed. All other work will be conducted remotely.

Examples of duties include:

- Providing support and clinical consultation to Outbreak Investigation Managers and their teams. Working collaboratively with, and providing consultation to, members of the investigation team to ensure quality care and timely disposition of issues.
- Participating in outbreak investigation conferences and cohort review and assisting the Chief Physician I in providing feedback to field staff.
- Serving as a consultant for COVID-19 outbreak investigation sites.
- Determining when an outbreak meets closure criteria and signing clearance letters as needed.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS (not mandatory)

- Residency training in Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Family Medicine or Preventive Medicine MPH
