WHAT IS A SCREENING?

A developmental screening is a way to check how your child is growing, learning, and developing. You can talk to your child's doctor about getting free screenings. They often use tools like the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) and the Survey of Well-being of Young Children (SWYC).

Screenings help the doctor see how your child is changing and growing. They can also help find any concerns with how your child thinks, moves, talks, or acts.

You can get FREE screenings at your child's doctor's office.
