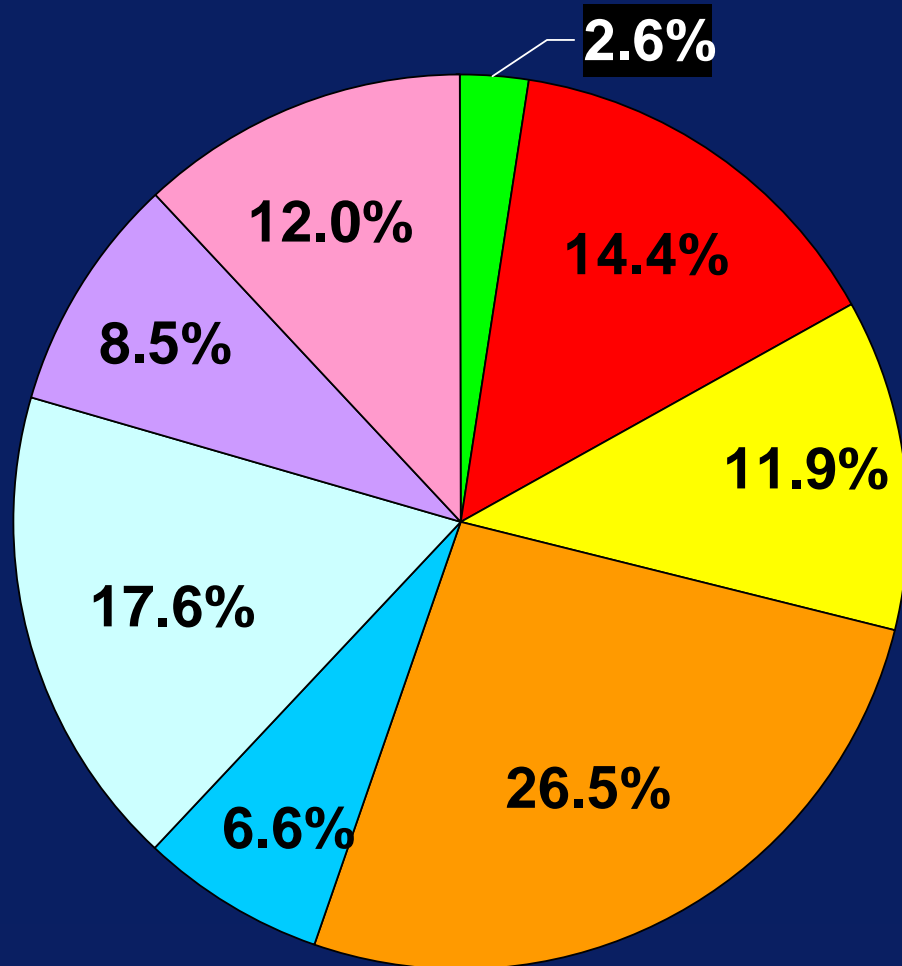

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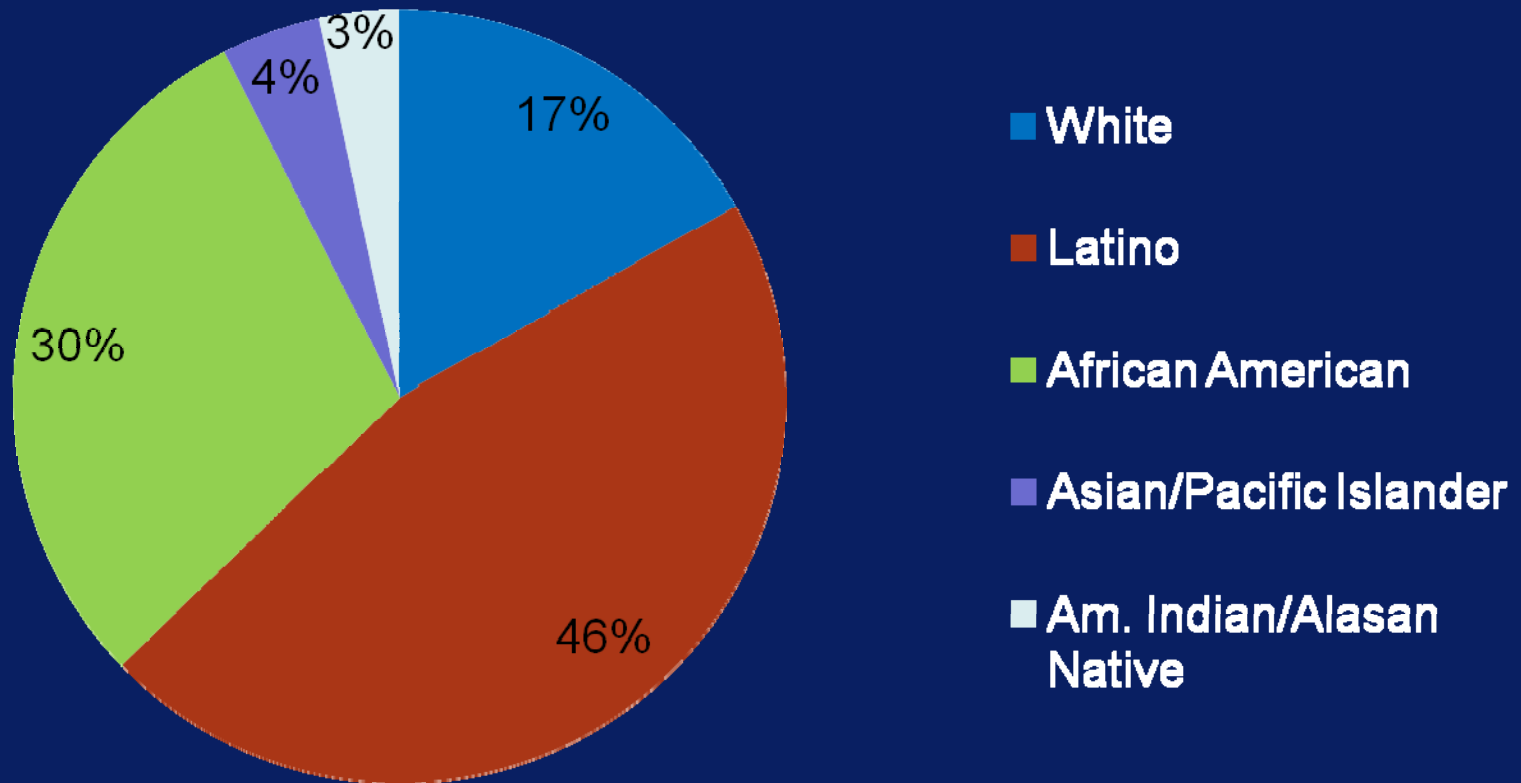

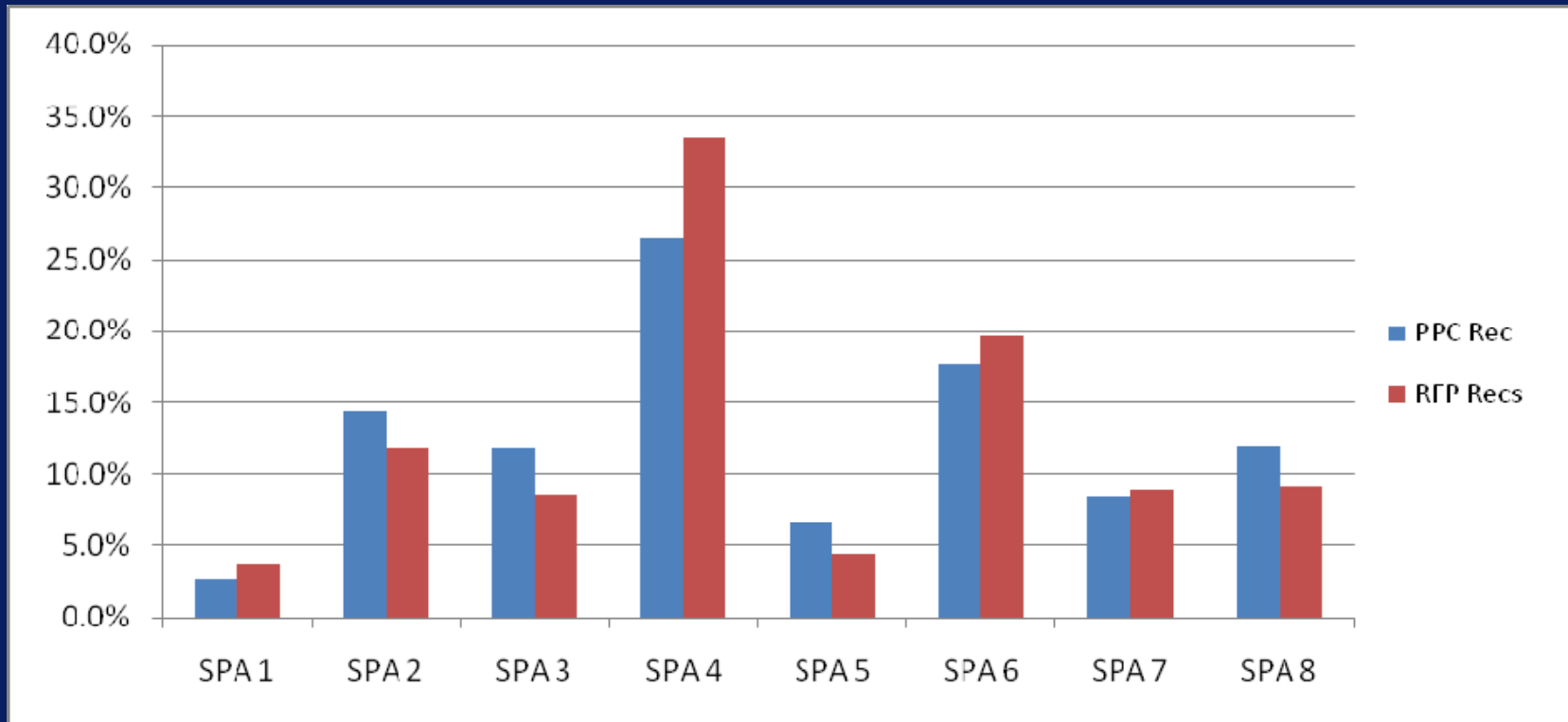
HE/RR RFP Results by Race/Ethnicity for All Categories



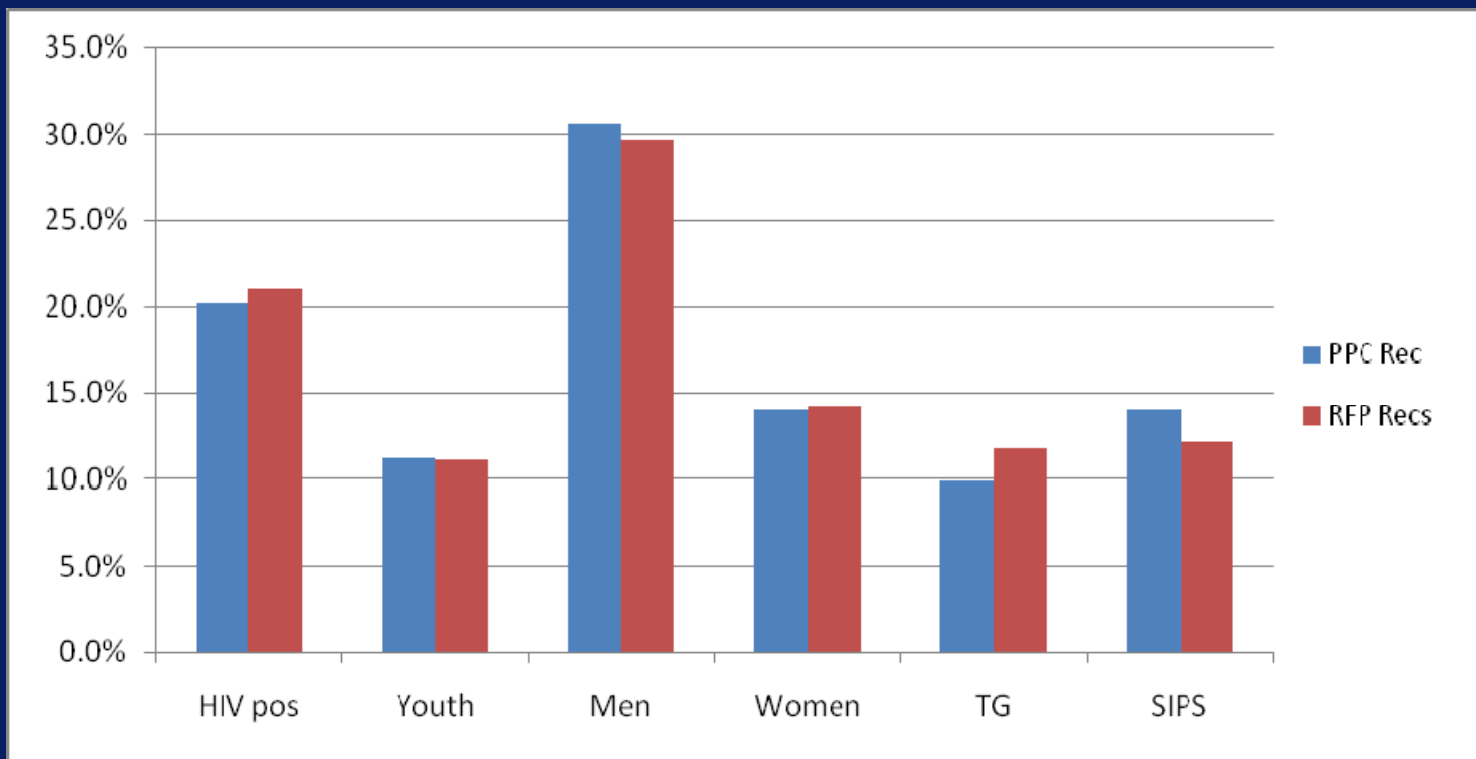
