

Hepatitis A Vaccination Clinics

June 3 – June 7, 2013 (Monday-Friday)

8 am-4:30 pm

As of May 31, 2013, 30 people have gotten sick with hepatitis A across five Western states: California, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, and Arizona.



It is believed that they got sick after eating **Townsend Farms**

Organic Antioxidant Blend, a frozen berry product. This product is sold at many stores, including Costco. Costco has removed this product from its store shelves.

Hepatitis A vaccine may prevent the disease—only if given within a 14-day time period of eating the frozen berry product.

If you have eaten any Townsend Farms Organic Antioxidant Blend within the 14-day time period, you should get the hepatitis A vaccine right away.

Affected residents are encouraged to seek treatment through their personal physicians. You can also get a free hepatitis A vaccination at one of our Department of Public Health Centers listed to the right.
