

Hepatitis A Vaccination Clinics

June 24-28, 2013 (Monday-Friday)

The LA County Department of Public Health will continue to provide free hepatitis A vaccinations for those who have eaten **Townsend Farms Organic Antioxidant Blend**, a frozen berry product sold at Costco. The hepatitis A vaccine may prevent the disease—only if given within a 14-day time period of eating the frozen berry product.

Affected residents are encouraged to seek treatment through their personal physicians. You may also get a free hepatitis A vaccination at one of our health centers listed below.
