Los Angeles County residents affected by the LA County Department of Public Health's new recommendations for vaccinating against invasive meningococcal disease are encouraged to seek treatment through their personal physicians. Those who do not have a regular doctor or health insurance may obtain a free meningococcal vaccine at the Public Health clinics listed below.

Recommendation: Meningococcal vaccine for both HIV-positive men who have sex with men (MSM), including men who may or may not identify as gay or bisexual, and MSM, regardless of HIV status, whose activities put them at higher risk.
