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Project Roomkey – Updated DVR Coordinator List

Project Roomkey is a coordinated effort to secure hotel and motel rooms in L.A. County as temporary shelters for people experiencing homelessness who are at high-risk for hospitalization if they contract Coronavirus (COVID-19). High-risk includes seniors 65+ and/or those suffering from chronic illness.

Criteria:

- Anyone 65 years of age and older

OR

- Anyone who meets the below criteria:
 - People of any age who have high-risk conditions:
 - People with chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma
 - People who have serious heart conditions
 - People who are immunocompromised including cancer treatment
 - People of any age with severe obesity (body mass index [BMI] >40) or certain underlying medical conditions, particularly if not well controlled, such as those with diabetes, renal failure, chronic kidney disease, undergoing dialysis or liver disease might also be at risk

All referrals to Project RoomKey are centralized-- survivors are connected to existing beds by

LAHSA staff, and referrals are made through an online portal.

Those agencies who participated in the Project RoomKey information session that occurred in April 2020 have access to the link. If you are interested in accessing the link, please contact your DV Regional Coordinator. The coordinators also have the ability to connect you to further resources.
