A 7-STEP PROCESS

1

Contact Public Health at (626) 430-5560 for Food Cart requirements or visit publichealth.lacounty.gov/eh for more information.



2

Refer to Mobile Food Cart Plan Check Guidelines at publichealth.lacounty.gov/eh.



3

Submit plan check application, 2 sets of plans & fees (\$746) to Public Health with proposed menu for review at your local plan check office. To find your local office call (626) 430-5560.



4

If plans are not approved simply revise & resubmit plans for review (Additional fees may apply).



4A

Once the plans are approved, construct the cart and contact Public Health to schedule a final inspection of the Mobile Food Cart at commissary or Baldwin Park Office.



5

If cart and menu are approved, you will be required to submit application for Public Health Permit and pay associated fees.



6

Public Health Permit issued. You are now ready to safely operate your Mobile Food Cart in Los Angeles County.



7

A routine inspection is scheduled annually or bi-annually based on the menu and the scheduled route.
