

FREQUENTLY USED TERMS	
<b>Alternate Water System</b>	Sustainable sources of water not supplied from fresh potable water sources.
<b>Commercial Buildings</b>	Includes hotels, retail, medical, mixed-use buildings, etc.
<b>Cross Connection Test</b>	A cross connection “shut down” is a field test where potable and non-potable water lines are pressurized together and one at a time to assure that there are no cross connections between the two plumbing systems. The test is the final step before a dual plumbed system is approved for use. The test typically usually requires multiple field inspectors and is required to be retested for all commercial properties that are dual plumbed.
<b>Dual Plumbing</b>	Potable in combination with non-potable water sources used to service interior fixtures. Potable and non-potable operate through clearly separated systems.
<b>Multiple Family Dwelling (MFD)</b>	<p>Five or more units on a single or adjoining parcels (includes apartments, condominiums, dormitories). Categorized with Commercial Buildings for pricing points.</p> <p>Any structure, including an apartment house, condominium, or any portion of structure, occupied, designed, or built, or rented for occupations as a home by five or more families, each living in a separate unit and cooking within such structure (Title 8.04.320)</p>
<b>Graywater</b>	Untreated wastewater that has not come in contact with toilet waste. Water from bathtubs, showers, bathroom wash basins, laundry.
<b>Rainwater</b>	Water that is collected before touching the ground.
<b>Recycled Water</b>	Tertiary-treated water produced from the three-stage treatment of municipal water. Recycled water is not for direct human consumption. Pantone 512/522c (purple) is the designated color for pipeline material, valve boxes, and signage for recycled water.
<b>Single Family Dwelling (SFD)</b>	<p>A single home on a single parcel. May include up to four separate residential units.</p> <p>Any structure, including an apartment house, condominium, or any structure, occupied, designed, or built, or rented for occupation as a home by less than five families (4 separate residential units or less), each living in a separate unit and cooking within such structure.</p>
<b>Stormwater</b>	Rainwater that has contact with the ground.
