



Data Access Form for the Los Angeles County Health Survey Public-Use Datasets

Office of Health Assessment and Epidemiology Los Angeles County Department of Public Health

There is considerable interest in the data collected through the Los Angeles County Health Survey (LACHS). The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (LAC-DPH) has made available public-use (de-identified) datasets for the 2015 and 2018 survey waves to external researchers (data users) to facilitate use of the LACHS data for public health research, planning, and evaluation.

To access the LACHS public-use datasets, data users must agree to the following terms:

1. The user will not share the LACHS public-use data with others as the data are for the exclusive use of the individual who requested the data.
2. The user will notify LAC-DPH of all writings and presentations that are based on the LACHS public-use data, including but not limited to reports, journal publications, abstracts, academic papers, and conference presentations. The user should submit reports and publications, along with dissemination plans to LAC-DPH (LAHealthData@ph.lacounty.gov) at least two weeks prior to dissemination.
3. The user will acknowledge LAC-DPH in all publications or presentations. Suggested acknowledgement is "This research used data from the (survey year) Los Angeles County Health Survey, released by the Office of Health Assessment and Epidemiology at the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health on (release date). The content of this publication or presentation is solely the responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily represent the official views of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health or any funders of the survey."
