Through the Alzheimers Disease Program Initiative, ACL seeks to enhance workforce capacity in the National Aging Network with the inclusion of dementia-capable Community Health Workers. As a result of this initiative, ACL intends to strengthen relationships with rural and underserved communities and address barriers to care for people living with dementia and their caregivers. Eligible applicants include Area Agencies on Aging. Twelve programs will be awarded for the 3-year project.
