# Lost your child's vaccine record? Here are a few places to look:

It's important to keep vaccination records ready and up to date. Documentation may be required for school, childcare, or extracurricular activities.

### **Doctors Office**

Children are often provided a **Yellow Vaccination Card** to bring to doctor appointments. If the card is lost, your doctor may be able to print another copy. If your child received vaccines from different locations, you may have to contact each location to get the full vaccine record.

# **Digital Vaccine Record**

Request a digital copy of your child's vaccine record online through the **Digital Vaccine Record (DVR) portal**. This digital copy can be used as proof of vaccination for your child's school requirements.

### **Previous School**

Try contacting the last school your child went to. Schools verify vaccinations for all their students and may be able to look up old records. Keep in mind records may be kept for only 1-2 years after students leave the school.



# **State Information Systems**

All states have registries of vaccine records. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has registry contacts and websites where you can learn how to request an official copy of your child's vaccine record.
