ABOUT RSV

- **Respiratory syncytial virus**, or RSV, is a common virus that affects the respiratory system and lungs.
- RSV is the **leading cause of hospitalization** for babies in the United States.
- RSV immunization **nirsevimab (Beyfortus)** can prevent serious illness and hospitalization for babies and at risk young children.

RSV IMMUNIZATION RECOMMENDATION

RSV immunization is recommended between October and March for:

- All babies under 8 months old whose birth parent did not get the RSV vaccine during pregnancy. It should be given just before RSV season or within a week after birth.
- Young children 8-19 months old who are at risk and are about to enter their second RSV season.
