Developing an Effective Board of Directors

Data & Surveys 101

This workshop will provide an overview of how various forms of data are used to provide insight into planning, operations and impact. The workshop will explore: qualitative and quantitative data; designing and conducting surveys for data collection; storing, managing and protecting data; and analyzing and reporting findings. Participants will learn how to put systems in place to track data over time and how to use data to identify trends and inform program decisions.

Researching Grants Efficiently: Increasing Your Odds for Success

Nonprofit executives will learn about the various ways in which organizations can identify grantmakers who are a fit with their organization's mission and priorities. Too often, nonprofits spend time submitting requests to funders when there is no legitimate chance of receiving a grant. This workshop will provide guidance on how to scale down and become more efficient in searching for funders, while increasing your chances for success. Participants will learn the various platforms that can be used to research funders and grant opportunities, and learn an approach for assessing fit with a funder.
