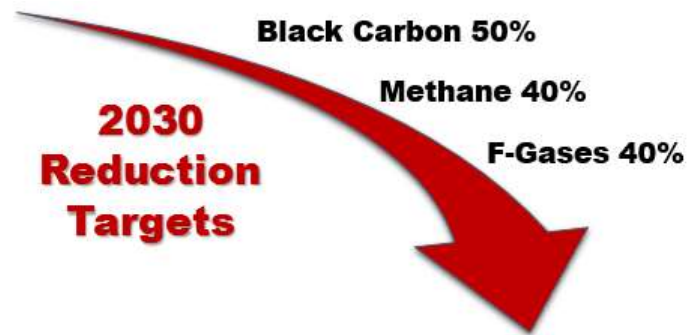

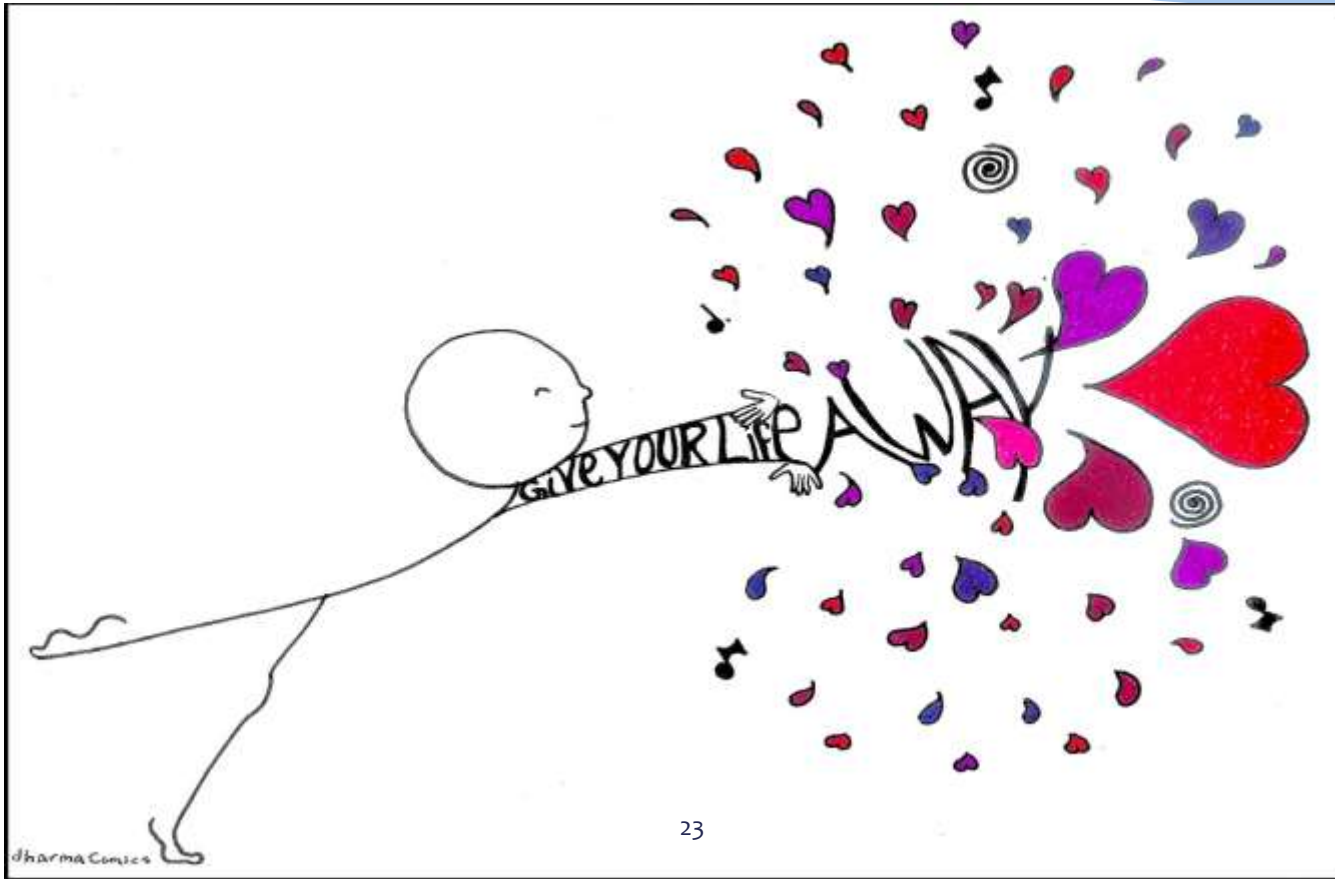
- * Webinar – May 25 at 11:00am, CAP will host a webinar on Spirometry Basics
