

Documentation of HIV Information

- I have been given information about HIV and my risks for getting HIV.
I have had my questions answered about HIV and the risk to me and my baby.
- I have been told that I may not be aware or informed of my partner's risk behavior.
- I have been told that I can reduce my risk for getting HIV by avoiding high risk behaviors including:
 - multiple sexual partners
 - using drugs and alcohol
 - having sex with a man who has had sex with other men
 - having sex with a man who has hemophilia who may have received blood transfusions
 - receiving blood by transfusion after 1979
 - having sex with a partner who has had multiple sexual partners or used drugs or alcohol
 - having sex without a condom
- I know that if I am infected with HIV, my baby can get HIV from me while I am pregnant.
- I have been told that if I have HIV infection, I can consider taking a medication that could reduce my baby's chance of getting the virus from me.
- I have been offered the opportunity to test for HIV, the virus that causes AIDS.
