



### Percent of Total Live Births by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2011









## Percent of Total Live Births by Source of Payment for Prenatal Care (PNC) and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2011



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


# Los Angeles County - Department of Public Health Number of Live Births by Zip Code\* and Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2011
