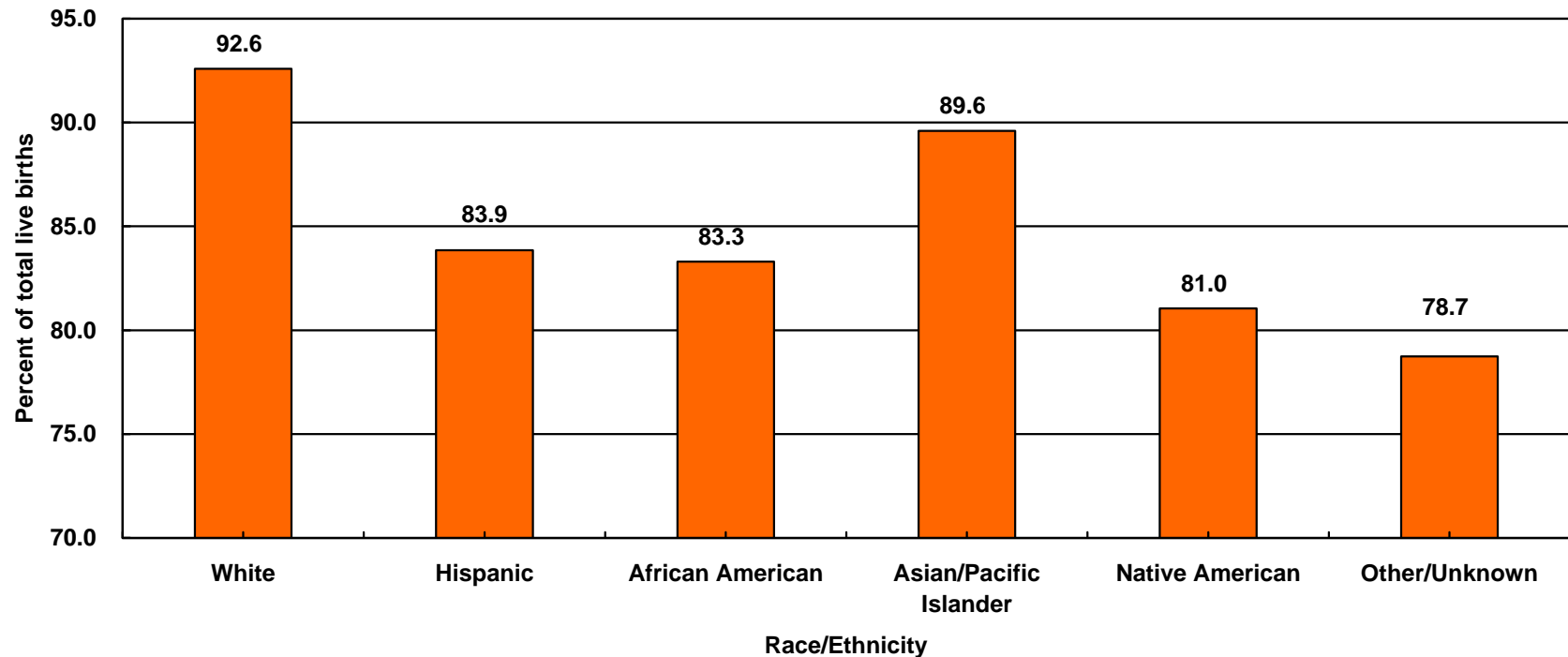


**Live Births to Mothers Starting Prenatal Care (PNC) in First Trimester

This measure excludes the prenatal care experiences of all women whose pregnancies did not result in a live birth.
