



A Local Health Emergency Has Been Declared Due to Critical Fire Events and Windstorm Conditions

REVISED Health Officer Order Limits Prohibition of Use of **Power Air Blowers, Including Leaf Blowers,** to Palisades and Eaton Wildfire Perimeter Areas Only to Reduce Health Risks from Fire Ash and Smoke

These devices stir up ash and particulate matter into the air, further worsening air quality and increasing health risks for everyone and their pets, particularly for those with respiratory conditions, older adults, children, and other vulnerable populations.

The Order only applies to the Palisades and Eaton Wildfire Perimeter Areas as defined by the CAL FIRE and The Wildland Fire Interagency Geospatial Services (WFIGS) Group.

Power air blowers may be used in all areas of Los Angeles County that are **outside** of the 2025 Palisades and Eaton wildfire perimeters.
