

KNOW THE SIGNS OF MONKEYPOX



The rash may appear in various forms - see below. Note: the rash may look different to these examples.



CONTACT YOUR DOCTOR RIGHT AWAY if you have a new, unexplained, rash or lesions on any part of your body. This is especially important if you were exposed to someone with or suspected to have monkeypox.

Until you know you don't have monkeypox, take steps to reduce the risk of spreading the infection including covering your rash and staying away from others. See <u>ph.lacounty.gov/monkeypoxisolation</u>.
