HOW TO GET TESTED FOR MONKEYPOX

Contact a doctor right away if you have a new unexplained rash or lesions on any part of your body.

This is especially important if you were exposed to someone with or suspected to have monkeypox. The doctor will assess you and may take swabs of the rash for testing.

1 Contact your healthcare provider

If you don't have a provider or health insurance:

- 3 Visit a Public Health Sexual Health Clinic

If it is suspected that you have monkeypox, until a doctor has ruled monkeypox out, take steps to protect others. This includes covering your rash and avoiding close contact with others.
