

Overall	 Over 9,000 Los Angeles County residents were hospitalized for self harm injuries and suicide attempts between 2016 and 2020. On average, this is over 5 hosiptalizations each day, and more than 36 hospitalizations each week.
Race/ Ethnicity	• Hospitalization rates were highest among Whites (22.6 per 100,000) and Blacks (22.0 per 100,000).
Sex	• Slightly more than half (55%) of self-harm/suicide attempt hospitalizations were among females.
Age Group	 Just over half of hospitalizations were among people under the age of 35 (n=5,000). Hospitalization rates were highest for 15-19 year olds (40.2 per 100,000). Hospitalization rates were lowest for the youngest (<15 years, 5.6 per 100,000) and oldest age groups (65+ years, 12.6 per 100,000).
Service Planning Area (SPA)	• Hospitalization rates were highest in SPA 1 (28.1 per 100,000) and lowest in SPA 7 (14.9 per 100,000).
Weapon	• Four out of every five patients were treated for poisoning, including drug overdoses.
