OVP Community Townhall Meeting	 The Office of Violence Prevention (OVP) is planning to expand TPI services to communities in Supervisorial District (SD1) and possibly SD3. Hospital Based Violence Intervention (HBVI) may also be expanding to 4-5 Trauma Centers in LA County. The Townhall meeting was held April 27th from 6-8pm and presented not only TPI but the outreach contractors who work in the community. CAP members voiced that going back to "normal" after COVID is not so simple. The unfortunate realities of the pandemic need to be acknowledged and addressed. Community Safety / Intervention Work	 SEA – Community of WWA & nearby areas have been facing large increase in violence. Intervention Workers echoed their concerns for their own safety, but still feel very motivated to continue their work. Recent events at Hellen Keller Park have resulted into a meeting to be held between Parks & Recreation, Law Enforcement, and Dept of Public Health. People for Mobility Justice – This is black and indigenous lead group that is planning to hold bicycle safety courses for the WWA Community.
