CHANGE membership tiers

- 1) Groups that endorse the CHANGE platform; join the CHANGE workgroup and general strategy meetings, and provide input about substance and strategy; and devote significant time engaging in carrying out CHANGE-related work/projects.
- 2) Groups that endorse the CHANGE platform, join the CHANGE workgroup and general strategy meetings, and provide input about substance and strategy, but that cannot devote significant additional time.
- 3) Groups that endorse the CHANGE platform, but do not join CHANGE workgroup and general strategy meetings (except if specifically invited), and do not make CHANGE decisions. They may take supportive actions periodically.

Membership Criteria

- Endorse the Louisville Charter and CHANGE Platform
- Participate in a certain percentage of the meetings – (two proposals: 50% & 2/3)
- Participate in at least one committee/workgroup
- Be willing to work on Chemicals Policy
