The Community Liaison Public Health Nurse (CL-PHN) is a Public Health Nurse who promotes the well-being of the community and seeks to prevent disease, reduce the effects of preventable chronic diseases, premature death and improve the quality of life among residents of SPA 3 by working with a Public Health Team and Community Stakeholders to develop and implement activities that help achieve SPA and Public Health improvement objectives.

The CL-PHN will perform the following duties:

- Participate in community programs that focus on creating healthy communities and a better quality of life for targeted populations.
- Participate with internal and external partners to identify expected outcomes in the health status of targeted populations.
- Promote and support the development of programs, policies, and services that are data driven for improved health status of community residents.
- Evaluate the health status of community residents along with programs, policies, and services to determine if outcomes are met and identify areas of improvement.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must currently be a permanent Los Angeles County employee who holds the payroll title of Public Health Nurse (for a lateral transfer) or
- Must be on a reachable Public Health Nurse Certification List.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Strong interpersonal skills
- Self-motivated and flexible
- Strong desire to work with community leaders and groups
- Proficient in Microsoft Office applications (Word, PowerPoint, Excel)
- Strong analytical and technical writing skills
