COMMUNITY LIAISON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS –
PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE**

We are looking to hire a very highly motivated, independent, experienced Public Health Nurse (PHN) that seeks to make a difference in our communities. This person must have excellent interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills as well as the ability to determine work priorities.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Promotes the well-being of the community by preventing disease, disability and premature death as a direct result of natural or man-made disasters
- Establishes strategic alliances and partnerships with the communities to assure that the action planning is designed to leverage local human, physical and economic resources to mitigate or minimize the morbidity and mortality associated with disasters
- Functions as a resource in the organizational development and training for the increased emergency response capacity within the Service Planning Area

Minimum Requirements

- Valid RN license and PHN certificate
- Lateral transfer or reachable on PHN list

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Assesses risk factors that would adversely affect the public's safety as related to natural and man-made disasters
- Analyzes assessment data to diagnose and establish internal and external emergency preparedness priorities
- Identifies priority opportunities and utilizes evidence-based information that will enhance action planning priorities associated with emergency preparedness
- Provides emergency preparedness training and guidance to community partners within the Service Planning Area based upon identified needs in an effort to build resilience.
- Participates in regular emergency preparedness training, exercises, and drills in order to effectively respond to natural or man-made disasters.
- Participates in mass prophylaxis activities to minimize the impact of communicable disease outbreaks within the Service Planning Area.
- Evaluates program activities during and after the interventions to assess the efficacy of the planning framework that promotes health and wellbeing as a result of a natural or man-made disasters
