The CL-PHN assists communities in their efforts to mitigate or reduce the effects of preventable chronic diseases, remedy the disproportionate health burden from diseases experienced by different ethnic/racial groups and assist protect local communities against potential devastating effects of natural or manmade disasters.

Job Duties:

- Participate in community programs that focus on creating healthy communities and a better quality of life for targeted populations.
- Participate with internal and external partners to identify expected outcomes in the health status of targeted populations.
- Promote and support the development of programs, policies, and services that are data driven for improved health status of community residents.
- Evaluate the health status of community residents along with programs, policies and services to determine if outcomes are met and identify areas of improvement.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must currently be a permanent Los Angeles County employee who holds the payroll title of Public Health Nurse (for a lateral transfer) or
- Must be on a reachable Public Health Nurse Certification List.
