The CL-PHN focuses efforts at the community and systems levels of practice on those interventions that help achieve Service Planning Area (SPA) 8 public health improvement objectives in collaboration with the Public Health Team. The CL-PHN assists communities in their efforts to mitigate or reduce the effects of environmental issues, preventable chronic diseases, remedy the disproportionate health burden from diseases experienced by different ethnic/racial groups and assist protect local communities against potential devastating effects of natural or man-made disasters.

JOB DUTIES:

- Provide health-related information to community leaders and the public to mitigate environmental risks and promote health with a focus on populations that are affected by cumulative impacts of multiple pollutants
- Participate in community programs that focus on creating healthy communities and a better quality of life for targeted populations
- Participate with internal and external partners to identify expected outcomes in the health status of communities and other targeted populations
- Promote and support the development of programs, policies, and services that are data driven for improved health status of community residents
- Evaluate the health status of community residents along with programs, policies, and services to determine if outcomes are met and identify areas for improvement

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse and a Public Health Nurse Certificate issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing and a valid California Class C Driver License
- Must currently hold the payroll title of a Public Health Nurse (for lateral transfer), or be on a reachable PHN list

- Self-motivated and flexible
- Strong desire to work with diverse communities
- Proficient in Computer Skills (Power Point, Excel, Word)
