POSITION INFORMATION

The People Experiencing Homelessness - Public Health Nurse (PEH-PHN) in SPA 1&2 promotes healthy people in healthy communities and sets out to advance the conditions that support optimal health and well-being of SPA 1&2 residents. PEH-PHN works closely with the Community Liaising Public Health Team to develop and implementactivities in line with SPA 1&2 and public health improvement objectives. The PEH-PHN implements activities that promote more robust outreach and engagement efforts targeting homeless encampments that are identified to have high health risk concerns.

The duties and responsibilities of the position include but are not limited to:

- Participate in community programs and collaborative partnerships that focus on creating healthycommunities and a better quality of life for individuals experiencing homelessness
- Provide outreach, information, referrals, face-to-face education, support, linkages, care coordinationand case management services as appropriate for outreach team clients who need assistance managing health conditions
- Provide field-based services and trauma-informed care to chronically homeless adults with serious mental illnesses, substance use disorders and/or physical health problems and addresses psychosocial needs for persons experiencing homelessness
- Integrate and apply current standards in the delivery of nursing care for persons experiencing homelessness
- Provide homeless resources and Public Health Nursing expertise to the community and internal partners

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse and a Public Health Nurse Certificate issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing
- A valid California Class C Driver License
- Must currently hold the payroll title of a Public Health Nurse for lateral transfer or be on a reachable PHN list

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to work with persons experiencing homelessness
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Self-motivated and flexible
- Ability to work independently and as a team member
- Strong problem-solving skills
