The Tuberculosis Control Program (TBCP) is seeking an experienced Public Health Nurse who provides nursing services to promote the well-being of the community and seeks to prevent disease, disability, and premature death due to Tuberculosis (TB) infection and disease among the residents of Los Angeles County (LAC). The PHN is assigned at the TBCP Headquarters to provide accurate and timely information to public and private providers as well as the community who call into the TBCP Office seeking consultation, recommendations and general information regarding the various aspects of tuberculosis control. The PHN supports the TBCP by assisting with data collection and assessment of select patient referrals, coordinating specific laboratory tests, and assisting with various special projects and activities. The PHN may travel to various locations in LAC to perform specific duties as needed. This position reports to a Public Health Nursing Supervisor (PHNS)

- Hold the payroll title of PHN
- Valid Driver's License

- Minimum 2 years of district PHN experience
- Strong knowledge of tuberculosis transmission principles, pathophysiology, and treatment standards
