PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE (PHN)

The District Public Health Nurse (DPHN) is a field nurse that collects comprehensive data pertinent to the health status of the residents and analyzes the data to determine the population diagnoses and priorities; identifies expected outcomes and plan that reflects best practices by identifying strategies, actions, plans, and alternatives to attain expected outcomes for the residents of SPA 1; and participates in required training and exercises. The job requires being recalled to report to duty during scheduled time off due to emergency needs of the community and accepts emergency assignments and work schedules.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse and a Public Health Nurse Certificate issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing and a valid California Class C Driver License
- Must currently hold the payroll title of a Public Health Nurse or be on a reachable PHN list

- Strong Interpersonal skills
- Good oral and written communication skills
- Self-motivated and flexible
- Computer literate
- Ability to speak second language prevalent in the community (Spanish)
