PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING SUPERVISOR

The Tuberculosis Control Program (TBCP) is seeking a Public Health Nursing Supervisor (PHNS) to oversee the TBCP Liaison Public Health Nurse (LPHN) Unit. Under the direction of the Nurse Manager, the PHNS assists in the planning, developing, implementing, evaluating and modifying the Hospital/Jail Liaison program. The PHNS will supervise 5 PHNs and 4 Senior Typist Clerks (STCs) at headquarters and at four off-site locations. The PHNS will be housed at the TB Control Headquarters office, located at 2615 S. Grand Ave. Room 507, Los Angeles, CA 90007.
