PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE SUPERVISOR (PHNS)

WORK LOCATION: Pomona Health Center, 750 S. Park Avenue, Pomona, CA 91766

We are looking to hire a very highly motivated, independent, Public Health Nursing Supervisor that wants to make a difference in our SPA 3 communities. The PHNS provides oversight and guidance to the District Public Health Nurses (PHNs). The PHNS supervises nursing services to promote the well-being of the community and seeks to prevent disease, disability, and premature death and improve the quality of life among the population of interest.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assists, evaluates, and analyzes workload according to the Public Health Nursing Practice Manual guidelines, program standards, and community needs.
- Participates in the overall administration of district nursing services which include hiring, program planning and implementation.
- Identifies expected outcomes and plan that reflects best practices by identifying strategies, actions, plans and alternatives to attain expected outcomes for the residents of SPA 3.
- Collects comprehensive data pertinent to the health status of the residents and analyzes that data to determine the population diagnoses and priorities.
- Utilizes models and principles of epidemiology, demography, and biometry, as well as social, behavioral, and physical sciences to structure data collection as stated in the Public Health Nursing Practice Manual
- Participates in required trainings, exercises, and meetings.
- Agrees to report to work during scheduled time off due to emergency needs of the community and/or emergency situations affecting work schedules.

Minimum Requirements:

- Must currently hold the payroll title of Public Health Nursing Supervisor (for a lateral transfer) or be on a reachable Public Health Nursing Supervisor Certification List.
- Currently hold a license to practice as a Registered Nurse and hold a Public Health Nurse Certificated issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing, and a valid California Driver License.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Strong interpersonal Communication skills
- Self-motivated and flexible
- Computer Literate
- Ability to work independently and as a team
