## **PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE**

### **Position information:**

The Public Health Nurse (PHN) in the Acute Communicable Disease Control Program (ACDC) Training and Response Unit will assist in the development and maintenance of public health emergency response plans and protocols, and ensures equipment and supplies for biological incident response. The PHN coordinates, participates, and provides trainings on biological incident response plans and protocols, and testing of response capabilities via exercises and drills. The position assists with planning, developing and evaluations of exercises for public health emergency response and other emerging infectious diseases. The PHN engages, networks, and collaborates with DPH representatives, other Program representatives and external partners regarding public health emergency response and training. This position will be involved in disease outbreak investigation and specimen collection of potential BT incidents or emerging infectious diseases in the field and/or hospital/ambulatory care settings. The PHN participates in required emergency preparedness training and exercises, and performs public health emergency duties as established by the Department.

- Minimum 1- 2 years Public Health Nurse experience
- Presentation and health teaching experience
- Strong epidemiological interview and disease investigation skills
- Strong, problem-solving, and analytical skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication
