#### Minimum Requirements:

• Be a permanent Los Angeles County employee who holds the payroll item of Registered Nurse I for lateral transfer, or must be on reachable Registered Nurse I Certification List

### **Examples of Duties:**

- Assist clinician in the nursing care of the TB, STD, PrEP, vaccines, covid testing and Communicable Disease clients.
- Performs a range of nursing tasks required by the service such as phlebotomy, specimen collection and processing, administering medications/injections and immunizations.
- Completes appropriate paperwork such as logs, reports, and forms.
- Nurse visit/triage unscheduled patients
- Consults with clinician regarding medical management issues
- Ensures the maintenance of emergency cart, pharmacy and clinic supplies.
- Reviews laboratory results and refers abnormal results to clinician.
- Assists in monitoring quality assurance, infection control and safety activities
- May coordinate the patient's medical care with private physicians, public facilities, first responders and other health care centers duties as assigned
